We are plugging along here in Romania and Moldova. Currently, we are on the eighth week of Coronavirus quarantine. Seems like Coronavirus just keeps dragging on more and more. But we are holding out hope the Coronavirus problem will end soon. It has sure made life hard for everyone across the world! On the bright side, God is teaching us patience!

The kids in our children's homes are doing as well as can be expected, being in quarantine. They are not allowed to leave the house under any circumstances. In fact, only one person is allowed to go out for groceries and other essential items. For us, this is Anca; the rest of us stay home. We are getting pretty creative, doing all sorts of activities with the kids. Anything to entertain them and keep them busy. We made some corn hole boards, lots of jumping on the trampoline, playing ball in the back yard, soccer, arts/crafts projects, and just about anything fun we can think of. Plus, the Romanian government has started virtual school for the kids, namely via WhatsApp and Zoom. Lots of tablets/phones at Finding Hope going during the school day! For now, the kids are loving virtual school. But soon, it will probably be old hat, and they will want to go to back to the block and mortar school.

Outreach in the Gypsy Villages:

Unfortunately, we have not been able to minister in the gypsy villages much because of the Coronavirus quarantine; though, we have sent them food and clothing via people who have permission to enter the villages for humanitarian reasons. We are praying the quarantine will lift soon, so we can get back to church planting and spreading the Gospel in the villages where we work.

Future Plans:

Things are still moving forward with starting a Finding Hope Children's Home in North Carolina. However, it has been progressing a little slower lately because of the Coronavirus pandemic. But, Lord-willing, it will happen sooner than later! We are hoping and praying the home will be up and running sometime in 2021. Please pray for us concerning this matter.
